A BED TOO SHORT AND A BLANKET TOO NARROW

Text: Isaiah 28:14-15, 18-20

INTRO: There is an old saying to the effect, "You've made your bed, you'll have to sleep in it." In Isaiah's time, Israel had been extremely lax in their service/obedience to God. They had grown to put their con-fidence in an alliance with Egypt to protect/deliver them from Assyria. See Isa. 30:1-2. Their provision was totally inadequate. Israel had made their bed. They would have to sleep in it. But what a miserable bed it was: a bed too short with a blanket too narrow.

Like Israel of old, many today are putting their trust in things which are totally inadequate to deliver them in the day of judgment.
